






Hardware Connection

UE330 is a Plug and Play device. Plug the USB cord of the UE330 into the computer's USB port and the white LED indicator above shall light up to indicate it is properly connected. Automatic driver installation takes a few seconds. Once installed the UE330 is ready to use.
